How we are making a difference

PeaceWomen Across the Globe understands that peace processes are dynamic: they include building, negotiating, implementing and sustaining peace. Grounded in this comprehensive understanding, **we work for the full, equal and meaningful participation of women in shaping peace** before, during and after armed conflict. Through our programmes, we tackle root causes, break cycles of violence, sustain peacebuilding efforts across generations and drive lasting peace.



Programmes in five contexts

Peace work begins long before negotiations start. Even amid armed conflict, activists create the conditions for peace. In **Ukraine**, we support women social leaders to strengthen their skills and build networks to implement local peacebuilding initiatives.

In **Sudan**, we enable women activists to raise awareness in their communities. We also connect them with exiled peacebuilders so they can bring their demands and perspectives collectively into peace negotiations. In **Colombia**, we are co-coordinating a political alliance of actors to exert influence and shape local peace dialogues.

Implementing peace agreements takes decades. This is why we focus on intergenerational approaches to peacebuilding in **Nepal** and in the **Philippines**. By providing opportunities for younger and older women peacebuilders to connect, we help sustain their efforts to hold authorities accountable.

A network in more than 30 countries

Our network **Feminists Connecting for Peace** brings together feminist peacebuilders, from women who are taking part in peace negotiations to grassroots activists. Being a member of our network provides them with greater visibility, safety, solidarity and access to people, knowledge and funding.

We offer in-person and online exchanges and access to international fora. Through our **Feminist Peace Initiatives**, we provide small grants to test new ideas. To date, we have supported initiatives in Afghanistan, Belarus, the Great Lakes region, Lebanon, Guam, among others. These seed grants allow women to bring their visions to life. In addition, they help us build relationships with new partners based on mutual trust.



Our story and our team

Our story began with the bold initiative to nominate **1000 women for the 2005 Nobel Peace Prize**.

The initiative laid the foundation for PeaceWomen Across the Globe as a feminist peacebuilding organisation.

Our team consists of 12 staff members in our international office in Bern, **Switzerland** and two staff members in Bogotá, **Colombia**. By opening the Colombia office in May 2025, we have taken an important step towards our commitment to decolonialise feminist peacebuilding.
